This office has completed review of the Remediation Work Plan (RWP) for the ITT Pontiac Street site located at 3700 East Pontiac Street in Fort Wayne, Indiana. After careful review by both the Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) staff and IDEM's technical staff, the RWP appears to meet the VRP objectives as established under IC 13-25-5-8.5*.

However, according to statute, the IDEM must make this document available for public comment. Therefore, the IDEM will public notice the RWP for thirty days at the Allen County Public Library and in the file room at the Office of Land Quality at IDEM. If no comments are received which require changes to the RWP and a public hearing is not requested and granted, a final RWP approval letter will be issued by IDEM's Assistant Commissioner.
