This letter is a follow-up in response to your 2006 Annual Compliance Certification, postmarked May 3, 2007. After review of this Annual Compliance Certification, it has been determined that the submittal does not meet the requirements of 326 IAC 2-8-5(a)(1)(C) for an administratively complete Annual Compliance Certification.

The following deficiencies have been identified that must be resolved in order to meet the requirements of 326 IAC 2-8-5(a)(1)(C):

1. IDEM requires that you submit the compliance status for each issue. We have found that the FESOP permit, 003-23009-00010, pertaining to 9/6/06 – 12/31/06, lacks the report on compliance for C.15 Emission Statement. Please note that Permit 003-13588-00010 is complete. Be sure that each submission responds to the correct conditions and that an original signature and date is included with both certifications.

A revised Annual Compliance Certification that addresses the deficiencies noted above must be submitted within fifteen (15) days of your receipt of this notice. You may either mail it to the address above or fax it to (317) 233-3257, Attn: Andrea Webster. A certification by the responsible official or authorized individual must be included with the revised Annual Compliance Certification.

The Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) has a nonrule policy document that was revised 6/26/02 concerning Annual Compliance Certifications. A copy of the nonrule policy and related documents are enclosed. You may use this nonrule policy and related documents to revise the Annual Compliance Certification and provide the necessary information. 4. Section C

To the best of our knowledge and belief, Fort Wayne Liquid Coatings, Pontiac Street plant was in compliance during the permit time period with conditions found in:

- C.1 Particulate Matter Emissions Limitations For Processes With Process Weight Rates Less Than 100 Pounds Per Hour; compliant, on a continuous basis, using knowledge of the operation to determine that the particulate matter emission rates for operations having a process weight rate less than 110 pounds per hour did not exceed 0.551 pounds per hour.
- C.2 Overall Source Limit; compliant, on a continuous basis, using knowledge of the operation to determine that maximum potential air emission rates were below the specified limits:
 - Miscellaneous regulated pollutants, 100 tons per year.
 - Any individual hazardous air pollutant, 10 tons per year.
 - The total for all hazardous air pollutants, 25 tons per year.
- C.3 Open Burning; compliant, on a continuous basis, using knowledge of the operation to determine that the company did not conduct any activity that met the definition of "Open Burning".
- C.4 Incineration; compliant, on a continuous basis, using knowledge of the operation to determine that the company did not operate an incinerator in incinerate any waste or refuse.
- C.5 Fugitive Dust Emissions; compliant, on a continuous basis, using knowledge of the operation and visual checks to determine that, to the best of our knowledge and belief, the company did not allow fugitive dust to escape beyond the property line or boundaries of the property, right-of-way or easement.

- C.17 General Reporting Requirements; compliant, on a continuous basis, using knowledge of the operation and records keeping to determine that quarterly compliance monitoring reports were completed and submitted in accordance with permit requirements.
- C.18 Compliance with 40 CFR 82 and 326 IAC 22-1 (Protection of Stratospheric Ozone); compliant, on a continuous basis, using knowledge of the operation to determine that, to the best of our knowledge and belief, all air conditioners were maintained, serviced and repaired in accordance with prescribed requirements.

To the best of our knowledge and belief, Fort Wayne Liquid Coatings, Pontiac Street plant was in compliance during the permit time period with conditions found in:

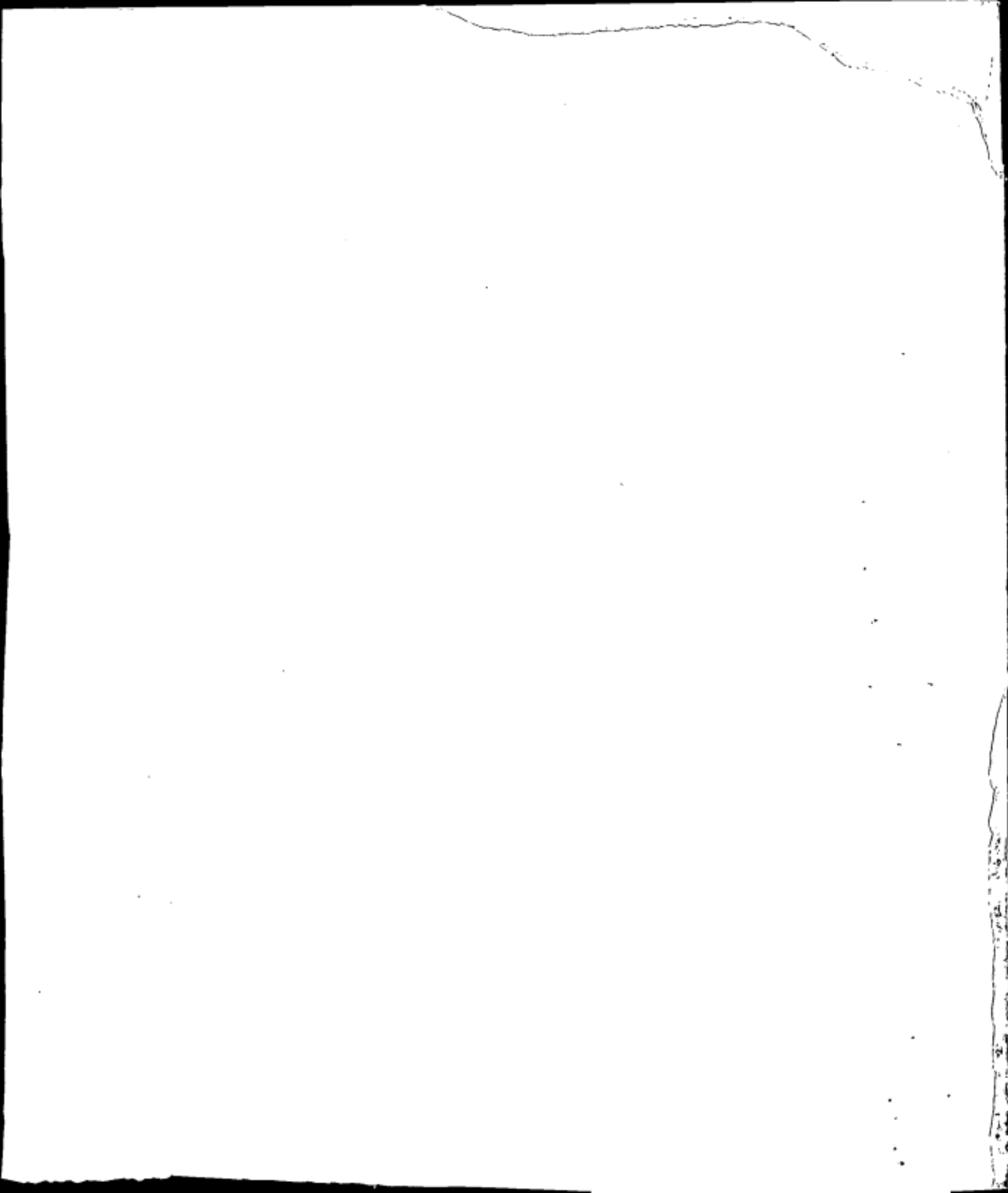
- D.1.1 Volatile Organic Compounds: compliant, on a continuous basis, using Material Safety Data Sheets, records of coating, thinner and additive use and related information to determine that VOC emissions from the airbrush paint booth were below 15 pounds per day,
- D.1.2 Volatile Organic Compounds Limitations: compliant, on a continuous basis, using Material Safety Data Sheets, records of coating, thinner and additive use and related information to determine that the average as applied VOC content of coatings applied to metal parts was below 3.5 pounds per gallon.
- D.1.3 Volatile Organic Compounds Limitations, Clean Up Requirements: compliant, on a continuous basis, using knowledge of the operation, work practices and visual checks to determine that all solvent used for cleanup or color changes was directed into containers.
- D.1.4 Particulate: compliant; on a continuous basis, using knowledge of the operation to determine that booth dry filters were in place and were operated in accordance with manufacturers specifications at all times when production operations were taking place in the booth.
- D.1.5 Preventative Maintenance Plan: compliant, on a continuous basis, using knowledge of the operation and records keeping to determine that there is a written plan and work procedures.
- D.1.6 Volatile Organic Compounds: compliant, on a continuous basis, using Material Safety Data Sheets, records of coating, thinner and additive use and related information to determine the average as applied VOC content of coatings used.

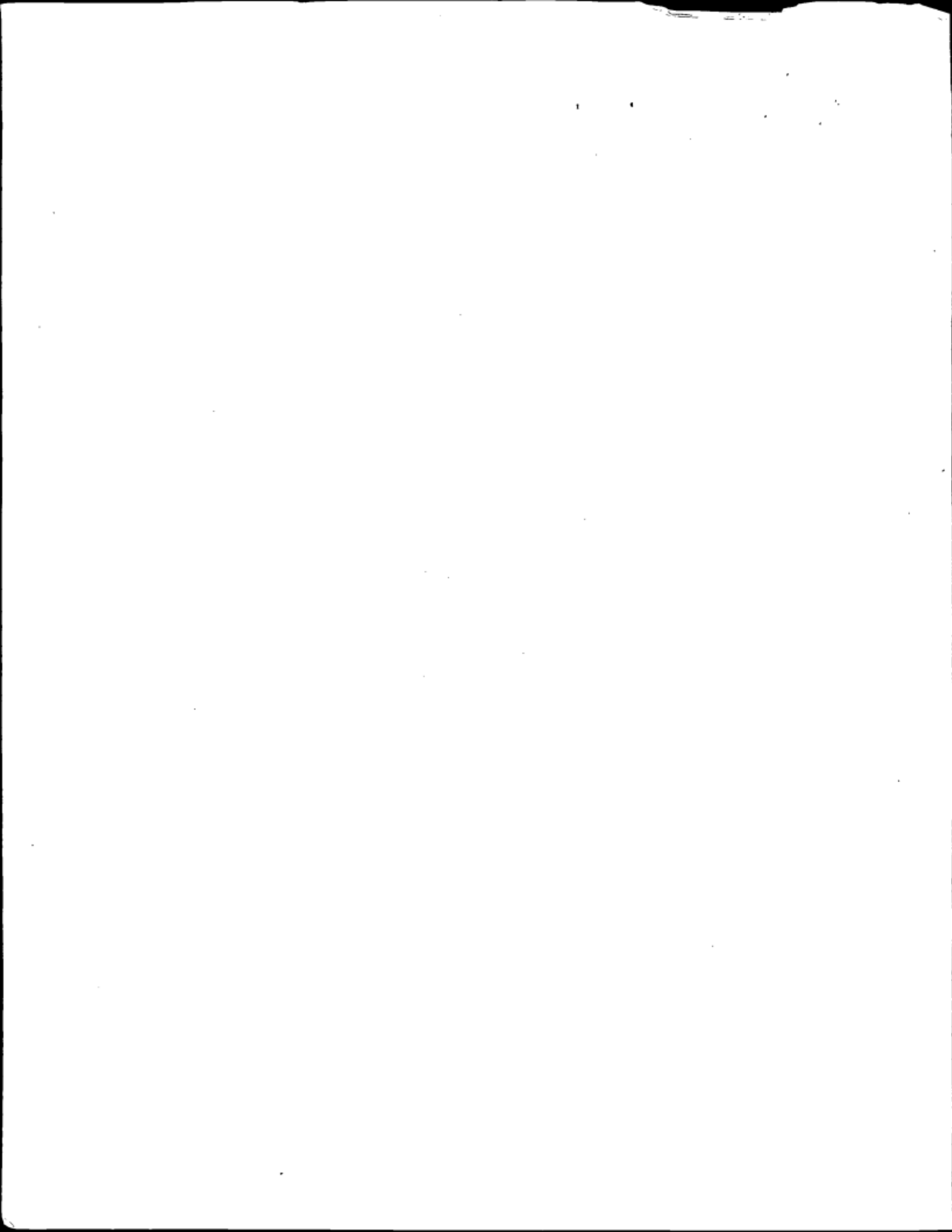

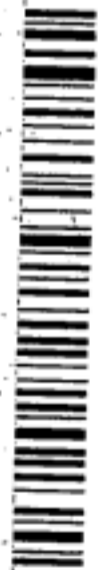

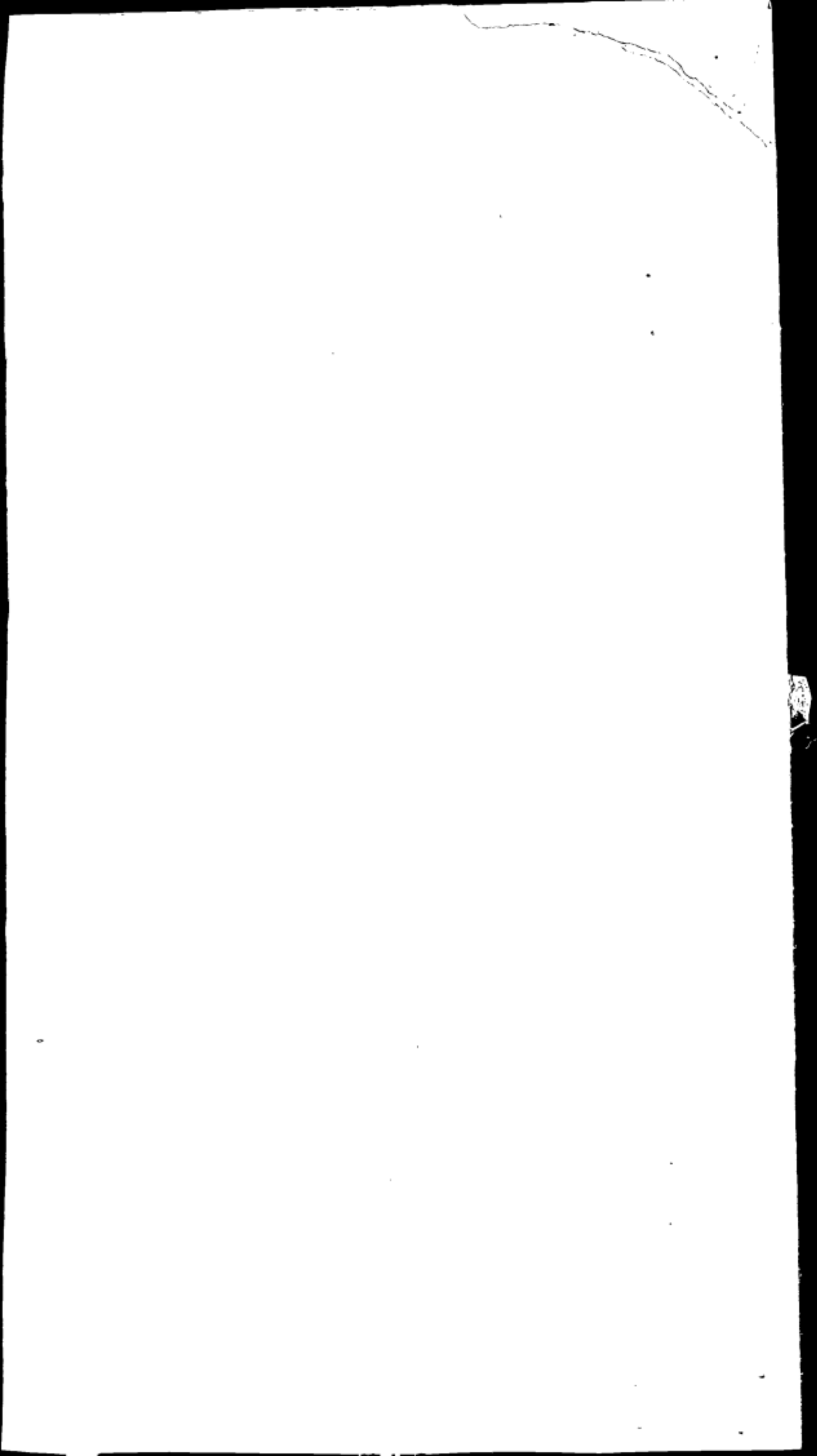
