DEED RESTRICTION:
Lake County, Indiana

United States Steel Corporation, a Delaware corporation ("USS"), hereby certifies that:

1. USS owns real estate in the North 1/2 of Section 25, Township 37 North, Range 9 West of the 2nd Principal Meridian in the City of Gary, Lake County, Indiana (the "Property").

2. A portion of Property depicted and more particularly described on "Exhibit A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (the "Facility") was used as a solid waste disposal facility.

3. The general types of waste that are stored on the Facility are non-municipal waste from steel making.

4. The location of the waste in the Facility is shown in Exhibit A.

5. The depth of the fill in the Facility is 25- 50 feet.

6. Exhibit A, which shows surface contours at intervals of two (2) feet, indicates:

- (a) final land surface water run-off direction;
- (b) surface water diversion structures after completion of the operation; and
- (c) final grading.

7. Pursuant to Title 329, Article 10, Rule 30, Section 7 of the Indiana Administrative Code (329 IAC 10-30-7), no construction, installation of wells, pipes, conduits, or septic systems, or any other excavation may be done in the Facility without approval of the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Environmental Management.

8. This land use restriction shall remain in full force and effect for so long as the Indiana Department of Environmental Management shall require and shall run with the land.
