SUBJECT: Permit Writer's Site Inspection

On December 14, 1984, Mr. Larry Dunbar, Mr. Larry Studebaker, and I conducted a site inspection of Indiana Steel and Wire, Muncie. Due to a communication oversight at that time, I was unaware that the facility did not wish us to see the entire site. Mr. Greg Clark and Mr. Mark Treter, company representatives, allowed us to see the former waste pile (now in a hopper) consisting of lead contaminated sand, the two indoor drum storage areas, a roll-off hopper containing D008 sludge, three tanks, and an acid storage tank (K062) that is part of a totally enclosed treatment works.

The facility also has a surface impoundment for which they have two delisting petitions pending. They wish to change their status from a TSD facility to a generator only by the delisting process and by 40 CFR 262.34 short-term accumulation (for the container/tank/waste pile storage areas). Thus, Indiana Steel and Wire has asked for and received a three-month extension to their Part B due date (January 31, 1985) from U.S. EPA, Region V, in order to carry out closure procedures and to wait for the finalization on their delisting.

At the time of the inspection, the Company did not wish to discuss the Part B application, merely their closure requirements. They wished to utilize the Policy #121 type of closure, but I explained to them that it did not apply to their facility.

I have sent the Company a Notice of Deficiency on the closure plan. U.S. EPA, Region V, will notify the State when the delisting petition is approved/not approved.
