INSPECTION OBSERVATIONS AND COMMENTS

Upon arrival at the site, I noticed muddy tire tracks leading out of Crisman's property and extending roughly 1,000 feet down the road. I drove along the length of the tracks to assess the scale of the violation. Then I returned to Crisman Sand's property and parked by the office. I entered and found no one inside. I did not feel safe traversing an active mine unescorted to look for management and did not know when they would be back. I departed the site and reached out to them upon my return to the office.

On May 6, 2024, I received a response from Crisman saying that the new fugitive dust control plan of sweeping the road every two (2) hours on muddy days was still in effect. The board will be voting on capital improvements to reduce fugitive dust on May 16, 2024. I discussed ways to improve the interim fugitive dust plan with Mr. Krueger. He agreed to check the roads every hour until a capital improvement was approved by the board.
