Please be advised the Solid Waste Permits Section, Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) has issued a permit modification to the City of Vincennes, 201 Vigo Street, Vincennes, IN, Land Application Permit No. IN LA 000536. The permit as issued on November 19, 2020, allows the Vincennes Wastewater Treatment Plant to land apply biosolids to agricultural land in Knox County. This modification approves three additional site-specific sites to their land application program. These sites have been reviewed and approved for use and are listed in the permit. You may own or reside at property <u>adjoining or near</u> the acreage participating in this recycling program.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 13-15-6-1 and IC 4-21.5-3 require that you file a Petition for Administrative Review with the Office of Administrative Law Proceeding (OALP). If you seek to have the effectiveness of the permit stayed during the Administrative Review, you must also file a Petition for Stay (see 315 IAC 1-3-2). The Petition(s) must be submitted to the OALP at the address below within 15 days of the date of this Notice or 18 days if you are receiving this notice by U.S. Mail:

The Petition(s) must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision, or otherwise entitled to review by law. Identifying the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by

permit number, name of the applicant, location, or date of this notice will expedite review of the petition. Additionally, IC 13-15-6-2 and 315 IAC 1-3-2 require that your Petition include:

- 1. the name, address, and telephone number of the person making the request;

- identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- 5. the issues, with particularity, for the request;
- identification of the permit terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing permits of the type granted or denied by the Commissioner's action; and
- a copy of the pertinent portions of the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review, at a minimum, the portion of the Commissioner's action that identifies the person to whom the action is directed and the identification number of the action.
