### **NOTICE OF DECISION**

Please be advised the Solid Waste Permits Section, Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) has issued a permit modification to the City of Vincennes, 201 Vigo Street, Vincennes, IN, Land Application Permit No. IN LA 000536.
