I just left you a Voice Mail. Chad Harris from the Newport Chemical Deport Reuse Authority and Terracon reviewed the attached letter and determined that there are two possible paths to continue the Newport Chemical depot Long-Term Monitoring (LTM) knowing that both areas (Decontaminated Waste Burial Ground -DWBG) and RDX-MA areas are to be monitored every two years (biennial), Terracon proposes to (a) postpone the RDX-MA monitoring for one year (this year) so that both the RDX-MA and DWBG monitoring takes place every two years at the same time; or (b) Alternatively, sample both areas this year.

Given the groundwater chemistry at the RDX-MA area, Terracon believes that monitoring at this area should cease soon and that option (a) above is an acceptable request.

Please review our request and let us know if IDEM agrees.
