OTHER ART DECO MOTIFS APPEARING IN BOTH STONE & METAL ARE SUNRISE AND FLORAL PATTERNS, CHEVRONS, STEPPED WINDOW HEADS AND WAVES. BOTH THE FOURTH ST. & SYCAMORE ST. 	the home of the local utility company.
