## Inspection Narrative

EQ Industrial Services Incorporated (EQIS) operates as a used oil processor, a used oil transporter, a used oil transfer facility, and as a Large Quantity Handler of Universal Waste. This site first notified as a RCRA Handler in late 2008. This site employs 23 working 1 shift Monday through Friday in this 25,000 square foot facility.

This Used Oil Processor inspection consisted of an opening conference, a tour of the used oil processing and storage area, a document review, and a closing conference.

EQIS collects and transports small containers (1 quart to 5 quart) of used oil from various retail operations (Home Depot, Lowe's, Meijer, etc.) and totes (275 -330 gallon) of used oil from Household Hazardous Waste events. They also occasionally pick up 55 gallon containers of used oil from industrial customers.

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Once received, container contents are visually inspected and compared to their profiles. All containers are tested on-site with a refrigerant leak detector (Prowler LD-5000) for the presence of chlorinated compounds. If chlorinated compounds are detected, those containers are further tested with a used oil chlorine/ halogen test kit. Containers with qualitative results in excess of 1000ppm chlorine/halogens are rejected. Accepted containers are barcoded, placed in secondary containment, and scanned daily. "Processing" consists of bulking small containers into 55 gallon drums or totes at this site. Universal Environmental Services takes samples of bulk containers and performs analytical off-site. Once analytical results are obtained, Universal will come back and transfer container contents to their tank truck destined for processing at their Florence, KY facility.

All used oil containers were properly labeled. No violations were observed. No further action is required.
