Comments: Today I met with Doug Kammerer onsite and conducted a routine inspection. All paperwork was reviewed and determined to be complete and in compliance. The rills and gullies on the east side of the landfill have been graded and seeded with plans to overseed as well. Most of the ditcheshave been cleaned but they are continuing to clean the remainder of them as well.

The lower level of the north side has been repaired by compaction, cover and seed. This area is beginning to put a final cap over 10 acres on the north side.

Today there is a drill rig coming to repair LS2. They are scheduled for 3 days and can hopefully remove the pump and replace it. There are no solid waste violations noted with today's inspection.

Confidential Information
