Information about this incident was shared with Marion County Public Health Department who will oversee the cleanup. The trucking company hired a consultant (CURA Environmental) who subcontracted onsite work to a local cleanup contractor (Environmental Restoration - Mark Weaver). Work is pending INDOT permit. Spill is contained. ER return and over-excavated impacted soil. Confirmatory samples were collected. Disposal documentation was submitted as part of a final spill report. No environmental threats remain.

**Comments:** Caller reports a semi crash with diesel released into the highway center median. Caller states the driver is owner/operator and was transported to hospital. No communication with that person. The towing vendor (Paddocks) hired a spill contractor (3Pro Env'tl) to stabilize the site. However, 3Pro, has not been retained by the trucking company. MCPHD expressed concern about the cleanup (over-excavation) and wanted to put it on IDEM's radar in case more input is needed further down the line.

Cole stated the MCPHD issued a notice of violation NOV against the trucking company and mailed it to the business address on record. Cole stated this one may need some state input to move forward.</p>

Weaver stated ER had submitted INDOT permit application and remains in communication with CURA about project cost estimates. Weaver stated ER had protected a drain with sorbent boom sort of on the western edge of that median. ER has marked the area of impact for over-excavation. Cole stated it appears things continue to move forward as fast as the INDOT permitting process allows.</p>
