A release from an Underground Storage Tank (UST) at EVSC Bus Transportation Fuel Station located at 824 Cherry Street in Evansville, Indiana was reported by Jarrod Richeson, Hinderliter Environmental Services, Inc. on June 14,2024. The Excess Liability Trust Fund (ELTF) provides a mechanism for the reimbursement of monies spent by eligible UST owners and operators for the clean-up of eligible releases of petroleum from UST systems. In order to seek reimbursement for corrective action costs from the ELTF for an eligible release, an eligible UST owner/operator or otherwise deemed eligible party must submit an eligibility application for evaluation and determination by IDEM. The ELTF eligibility application can be found at www.in.gov/idem/5157.htm#olq_ust_eltf. ELTF eligibility applications can be sent to the following email address ELTFEligibility@idem.in.gov. This letter is not a determination of ELTF eligibility.

Current statutes allow UST owners and operators to pay past due UST fees for releases discovered after July 1, 2016, within 60 days of release confirmation. When paid within 60 days of release confirmation, IDEM will waive the additional amount by which ELTF reimbursement would otherwise be reduced. Information regarding the "additional amount" assessment can be found in Ind. Code13-23-9-1.3.
