**Comments:** The current permit for this facility will expire on April 9, 2025. To operate past this date, the Newton County Landfill Partnership must submit a renewal application on or before December 10, 2024. According to site personnel present during this inspection, facility representatives and consultants are already working on the renewal application.

A routine inspection was performed on June 25, 2024. Due to current heavy rains and strong winds today, a drive throughout the inside of the landfill was not performed. This inspection therefore consisted primarily of a records review and visual inspection from the outside perimeter of the landfill.

As I approached the landfill, I noted no blowing trash or litter on area roads or fields, indicating that the landfill is properly confining the solid waste to inside the facility boundary. I then met with Mr. Craig Drinski, Ms. Natalie Murphy and Mr. Dave Steffel, in the main office, and we discussed site conditions. I was shown an updated plot plan from the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter and the March 2024 fly-over. The active face of the landfill is in Cells 6 West and 6 East. The seeding activities that took place in the Late Spring of 2024 in the north and east sides of Cells 8 & 9 are showing growth, and any rills or gullies that developed have been quickly addressed to further prevent sedimentation and erosion. The Bi-Monthly Self Inspection binder was presented and reviewed by this inspector. Leachate levels are being properly monitored and are showing no signs of any major fluctuations. The records reviewed appeared to be in order.

When I returned to the Northwest Regional Office, I reviewed information regarding a recent fire that took place at the landfill during this previous quarter. On May 12, 2024, at 12:20 pm, a fire was detected at the working face of the landfill (Incident #112358). Site personnel quickly assessed the situation, and contained and extinguished the fire, and the local authorities and IDEM were properly notified of this event.

The landfill is well-maintained and is operating in compliance with the current IDEM permit and 329 IAC 10. I noted no solid waste violations with the items and areas inspected.
