Dear Mr. Yoder:

The Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) staff of the Drinking Water Branch has conducted a review of your Arsenic drinking water analysis report.

This review noted the following detection:

Contaminant	Sample Date	Result	Monitoring Requirement
Arsenic	6/3/2024	0.014 mg/l	Begin <u>quarterly</u> arsenic monitoring during July- September 2024 and continue until further notice

The result of your arsenic sample collected on 6/3/2024 showed a level of **0.014** mg/l. This is not a violation nor is there an immediate health risk, even though the result is **above** the arsenic maximum contaminant level (MCL) of 0.01 mg/l. However, this detection triggers additional sampling requirements for arsenic to determine any future potential health risks. Compliance with the MCL is based on the *running annual average* sample result.

In accordance with IAC 8-2-4.1 your public water system must begin monitoring <u>quarterly</u> for arsenic beginning in the third calendar quarter (July-September) of 2024 and continue until further notice.
