This site visit was a routine inspection. The farm consists of 2 poultry barns and a manure storage building. The allowed animal capacity is 58,000 layers. There were 58,000 layers onsite during the inspection. The permit expires on 7-12-2028.							
A review of the operating record requirements was completed. All operating record requirements were present and in compliance. Kari Simpkins, consultant, helped prepare the requires records.							
Some manure is applied to crops but most is sold to Josh Fiechter. Bruce Herr has a fertilizer business license and a fertilizer distributor license from the State Chemist. The most recent manure samples were obtained on 2-28-2024. Soil samples were less than 4 years old. Manure application records indicated that manure was applied at appropriate agronomic rates. Marketing and distribution records were inspected and in compliance.
