Re: Inspection Summary/ Noncompliance Letter

New Haven Combined Sewer System NPDES Permit No. INM020346 New Haven, Allen County

An inspection of the above-referenced facility or location was conducted by a representative of the Indiana Department of Environmental Management, Office of Water Quality, pursuant to IC 13-18-3-9. A summary of the inspection is provided below:

Date(s) of Inspection: June 26, 2024

Type of Inspection: Reconnaissance Inspection Inspection Results: Violations were observed.

The following concerns were noted:

The Records/Reports evaluation generated an unsatisfactory rating. Part I. B. 3 of the permit requires the permittee to submit monitoring reports postmarked no later than the 28th day of the month following each completed monitoring period. These reports shall include the Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) and the Monthly Report of Operation (MRO). At the time of the inspection, it was determined you have not submitted records for March 2024 and April 2024. The facility needs submit these reports as soon as possible. It was also noted that the facility was late submitting reports for June 2023, September 2023, November 2023 and January 2024.

The facility had an incident April 2nd in which a contractor hit a line in the collection system. During this incident, some sewage leaked out of the collection system until the facility was able to shut it off and the line was repaired/replaced. The facility was advised to report the incident to IDEM as a Bypass/Overflow when it occurred. As to this date, the facility has not reported the incident. It is protocol during these situations that the occurrence should be reported within 24 hours. The facility should report it as soon as possible.

Part II. A. 1. of your permit requires you to comply with its terms and conditions. Any noncompliance with the terms of your permit may subject you to an enforcement action which can include the imposition of penalties. You are required to immediately take all necessary measures to comply with the terms and conditions of your NPDES Permit, specifically those violations identified above.

Effective immediately, IDEM is initiating a program strongly encouraging domestic wastewater utilities to perform cybersecurity vulnerability assessments, and to take actions to mitigate identified vulnerabilities and increase the cybersecurity resilience of Indiana's water sector. IDEM will continue to share important updates on the cybersecurity of the water sector.

Within 30 days of receipt of this letter, a written detailed response documenting correction of the concerns listed above and/or a plan for assuring future compliance must be submitted to this office. Failure to respond adequately to this letter may result in formal enforcement action. The facility must report overflows pursuit to 327 IAC 2-6.1-7, that states, any sewage discharged from the sanitary sewer system must be reported and properly mitigated. Overflows from the sanitary sewer collection system must be reported to IDEM by emailing a completed copy of a Bypass/Overflow Incident Report - State Form 48373 (download at http://forms.in.gov/Download.aspx?id=5462). The facility must fill out an overflow/bypass report for any future incidents to IDEM by emailing a completed copy of a Bypass/Overflow Incident Report.
