

would be reportable to IDEM. As the trial period with the current equipment concludes, a more permanent solution will be determined.

The containment area around the sulfuric acid storage tanks was not being used as designed. This containment area had a significant volume of "muddy" water present during this inspection. Water was being pumped back into the plant to be reused. The water from this containment area is not permitted to be discharged via any outfall. During the inspection, IDEM requested a complete flow diagram from the facility. This would include all water including process water, cooling water, recycled water, and storm water.

The requested records were available and appear complete and accurate. All indicated no discharge.

The Enforcement evaluation generated a marginal rating. Some quarterly reports have not been submitted. The 2nd quarter 2024 quarterly report for 2020-2758-W is due by July 10, 2024. Expectations for what should be included in the report were discussed during the meeting.
