Dear Mr. Viktor Kidun:

A representative of the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM), Office of Air Quality (OAQ), has reviewed a Permit Application concerning Patrick Industries DBA CANA, Inc. located at 29194 Phillips Street in Elkhart, Indiana. As a result of information obtained during that review, IDEM alleges a violation of Permit No. 44866, Condition B.20, Source Modification Requirements, 326 IAC 2-7-10.5, 326 IAC 2-7-12, and has occurred.

At the time of the review, the following violations were noted:

- 1) According to Permit No. 44866, Condition B.20, 326 IAC 2-7-10.5 and 326 IAC 2-7-12, Source Modification Requirements, and Permit Modifications. An owner or operator of a Part 70 source proposing to: (1) construct new emission units; (2) modify existing emission units; or (3) otherwise modify the source as described in this section; shall submit a request for a modification approval in accordance with this section.

It was determined during this review of the July 31, 2023, Permit Application that Patrick Industries, dba CANA, Inc. modified and operated the following six (6) spray booths (SS-11, SS-21, ST-22, SB-1, SB-2, and SB-3). CANA conducted an audit of the emission units on site. During this audit it was determined that the six (6) spray booths (SS-11, SS-21, ST-22, SB-1, SB-2, and SB-3) had an increased production rate and the coatings had been changed in all six booths. This resulted in a change in potential to emit (PTE) of particulate matter (PM), PM₁₀, and PM_{2.5} of 50.45 tons per year (TPY).

This is a violation of Permit No. 44866, Condition B.20, 326 IAC 2-7-10.5, and 326 IAC 2-7-12, Source Modification Requirements and Permit Modifications.

This matter will be referred for formal enforcement action. IDEM Office of Air Quality would like to take this opportunity to encourage discussions concerning the facts of the case, any additional information that may be available, and to provide you with information concerning the enforcement process.
