Dear Nate Simons:

The Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM), Office of Air Quality (OAQ), received a five (5) year open burning approval request from Blue Heron Ministries. At this time, IDEM approves the request to conduct a 2 unit, 20.4 total acre prescribed burn of grasses, forbs, leaf litter, and encroaching successional growth for native vegetation restoration/maintenance purposes at the Scudder's Residential Prairie, located at 15 E 700 S in Wolcottville, LaGrange County.

The following contacts must be notified at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance of the date and time of the burning:

- LaGrange County Health Department
- LaGrange County Sheriff's Department
- Wolcottville Volunteer Fire Department
- IDEM Northern Regional Office (IDEM NRO@idem.IN.gov)

Following are the conditions for the prescribed burn:

- 1) Only vegetation shall be burned.
- 2) No burning shall be conducted:
 - a. When an Air Quality Action Day (AQAD) has been issued for ozone and/or PM_{2.5}. An AQAD is declared when health levels are forecasted to be "Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups" or greater;
 - b. When an open burning ban has been declared by either state or local officials (www.IN.gov/dhs/burnban/); or
 - c. During unfavorable meteorological conditions (high winds, temperature inversions, and/or air stagnation).

- 3) Burning shall be conducted during daylight hours only, and all fires shall be extinguished prior to sunset.
- 4) This burn is exempt from the 1,000 cubic foot size limitation of 326 IAC 4-1-4.1(d)(13).
- 5) If at any time the fire creates an air pollution problem, a threat to public health, a nuisance, or a fire hazard, the burning shall be extinguished.
- 6) This approval letter shall be made available at the burning site to state and local officials upon request.
- 7) Adequate firefighting equipment shall be on-site for extinguishing purposes during burning times.
- 8) Burning may take place within one hundred (100) feet of any structure or powerline; or three hundred (300) feet of a frequently traveled road, fuel storage area, or pipeline, only if adequate precautions are taken. Wind speed, direction, mixing height, and transport winds shall be considered prior to beginning the burn so that there is minimal or no impact to nearby roads, structures, powerlines, fuel storage areas, or pipelines.





- 9) Fires must be attended at all times until completely extinguished.
- 10) All burning must comply with other federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and ordinances.
- 11) The issuance of this 5-year approval is subject to the description of the burning contained in the burn plan submitted with this approval request application (copy enclosed). Any change in the proposed burn plan must receive an additional approval letter unless the change is to reduce open burning submitted in the burn plan, or the change is to conduct burning exempted under 326 IAC 4-1-3.
- 12) This approval does not become effective until after fifteen (15) days from the date of publication in the LaGrange Standard.

This approval expires on July 1, 2029.

NOTICE OF OPEN BURNING APPROVAL PB-292455

Notice is hereby given that the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) has approved a 5-year request submitted by Blue Heron Ministries to conduct a 2 unit, 20.4 total acre prescribed burn of grasses, forbs, leaf litter, and encroaching successional growth for native vegetation restoration/maintenance purposes at the Scudder's Residential Prairie, located at 15 E 700 S in Wolcottville, LaGrange County.

Any affected person wishing to challenge this decision is required by Indiana Code (IC) Section 4-21.5-3-7 to file a petition for administrative review. (Please note that a "petition for administrative review" is not a compilation of interested party signatures but is a legal document, the requirements of which are described in IC 4-21.5-3-7.) The petition must be submitted in writing to N-501E, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, within fifteen (15) days of the publication of this newspaper notice.

Pursuant to IC 13-14-8-11 (formerly IC 13-7-7-6), IC 4-21.5-3-5 and IC 4-21.5-3-7, this decision will become effective fifteen (15) days after the publication date of this newspaper notice or, in the case of individuals who have received personal notifications, eighteen (18) days after the mailing date of this Notice of Approval unless a petition for review is submitted by an affected party. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(d), the Office of Environmental Adjudication will provide an interested party with notice of any pre-hearing conferences, preliminary hearing, or orders disposing of the review of this decision if a written request is submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication. PRESCRIBED BURNING PLAN

AREA NAME: Scudder

Physical Address: 0015 E 700 S Wolcottville, IN 46795

County: LaGrange, IN

Burn Unit size: Unit A: 7.76 acres, Unit B: 12.3 acres

Projected burn date: January 1 2024 – December 31 2029

Description of area: The burn units is owned by Mike & Sarah Scudder. The level to gently rolling fields were planted with warm season grasses, native forbs, and a small area with seasonal wetland forbs in the winter of 2019. There are planted tree islands at the perimeter of both units. The tree islands are planted with more forbs and less grasses than the open prairie. A walking path surrounds both units and also around some of the tree islands.

Unit A is shaped like a square with a small chunk taken out of the southern portion. It is bounded on the west by a gravel drive with a warm season grass prairie and open semi-wet woods. The north is bounded by a gravel drive for the western half with wet woods just beyond, while the eastern half is bounded by upland woods. The east is bounded by upland open woods that has a two-track lane paralleling the line. The south is bounded by county road E 700 S with a portion of the center going around a cemetery.

Unit B is mostly square shaped with a long strip heading north along the western half. It is bounded on the west by a gravel drive with a wet woods and board walk just beyond. The northern and eastern lines of the protrusion and north line of the square is bounded by a wet woods that opens into open water of Dallas Lake. The east line of the square is bounded by a fence line of trees with an agricultural field just beyond. The south is bounded by upland woods. The same woods that is on the north side of unit A.

Fire control lanes are ten (10) foot mowed grass and the gravel drive.

Burn objectives:

- 1. Reintroduce a natural phenomenon in the management of the units.
- 2. Top-kill any woody brush to set back succession.
- 3. Reduce litter to assist in the continued establishment of the newly seeded areas.
- 4. Suppress cool-season grass to encourage expansion of prairie vegetation.
- 5. Stimulate germination and establishment of the newly planted prairies.

Previous burn history: The units have been burned semiannually since 2021

Range of acceptable weather conditions:

Wind speed: <11 mph at eye level Wind direction: southwest and northwest not



Firing techniques projected; effects of wind shift during the burn: With a south wind, a ring fire will be attempted for unit B. Unit B will be completed first, once unit B is secured unit A will be attempted with a modified ring fire. 4X4 and water packs will assist in control line wetting and will be available to advance in the event of an escape.

Unit B

Starting on the most northern line, 2 ignition/suppression crews will travel in alternate directions and will back and flank burn along the control lines. The head fire will be ignited one adequate black is obtained on the downwind and flank sides of the fire.

Unit A

Starting in the middle of the northern line, 2 ignition/suppression crew will travel in alternate direction and will back and flank burn along the control lines. Once each group reaches the south east and south west corner, and there is an adequate amount of black on the flank and downwind sides of the fire, they will light head fire by traveling straight to the middle of the north line of the cemetery. From there they shall proceed in alternate direction around the cemetery back and flank burning. Once they have reached the south line and an adequate amount of black has been obtained, they will light head fire

Safety zones are in blackened areas, mowed control lanes, and gravel drive.

Contingency plans: The burn boss is in charge of coordinating all contingency plans. Crew members will be instructed to directly notify the burn boss of conditions that may warrant initiation of a contingency plan. Each crew member will have direct contact with the crew boss via hand-held radios and/or cell phones. Personnel safety zones are in blackened areas, a pond, and two-track lanes. Near the south west corner of unit A, will be the staging the staging area and the primary safety zone. If a contingency plan is put into effect due to weather or fire behavior changes, crew will retreat to the primary safety zone. Escape routes to the safety zone include mown fire control lanes, gravel drive, and blackened areas. The burn boss will be responsible to contact emergency response if the conditions warrant. The burn boss will coordinate with responding emergency units.

Sherriff dispatch will be informed prior to the fire to contact the crew boss of complaints of smoke affecting private residences. In the event that dispatch instructs the crew boss to shut down the fire, the crew boss will initiate shut down procedures. All ignition operations will cease. Crew assignments will be given by the burn boss to redirect efforts to fire suppression. Water packs, and the truck pumper will be used to put the fire out.

In the event of an escape, the crew member spotting the escape will contact the burn boss. The burn boss will initiate contingency operations. All ignition operations will cease. Suppression will begin from an anchor point and will advance along the flanks (from the black) toward the head until the escape is controlled. In the event direct attack does not control the escape, alternate firing of land upwind of the escape may contain the escape. Should alternate firing not be feasible or deemed ineffective with 15 minutes, emergency back-up will be called by the burn boss.

Should a 180° wind shift produce winds from the north, fire will be driven towards the open woods from unit B. The prepared control lines should serve as a fire break. If the fire enters the woods, the rate of spread will be slower than in the open field. Time should allow for control of an escape into the woods. For unit A, the fire will be driven towards the cemetery and the paved county road E 700 S. The control line and road should serve as fire breaks. Should the fire enter the cemetery, the mown lawn grass doesn't contain enough material to sustain a fire.

Fire breaks to prepare: Mown ten (10) feet fire breaks at the unit perimeter will be prepared prior to the burn.
