OSC Patterson requested pictures from homeowner but not received. Puddle in grass has persisted for a month and a half. Grass is growing in the puddle, OSC Patterson notified wastewater utility and Jason Palin. WW Hendricks County Regional Sewer headed out to check their line.

6/24/2024- Correspondence follow up with Hendricks County Regional Sewer, no answer to weekend check. They will look into it.

06/25/2024- Follow up with Hendricks County Regional Sewer, advised not a wastewater issues. They advised it is a water leak and advised homeowner to contact Citizens. OSC McBeth conducted field response, soil in area was saturated with water, contained a bio-sheen. Area appeared to be a water leak, and referred homeowner to contact Citizens.

No further action needed from IDEM ER at this time.

No signs of oil and other pollutants, believed to be a water leak and advised homeowner to contact Citizens.
