### Site History:

Site is a VA Hospital. Three (3) USTs were removed in 1992 per closure report (VFC Doc# 22795215). One (1) UST was removed in 1993 per closure NF (VFC Doc# 22815195, pg 6). Three (3) USTs were removed in 1998 per closure report (VFC Doc# 22815239). One (1) UST was removed in 2013 per closure report (VFC Doc# 82883992). Building 55 10K UST was originally installed in 1976 and then upgraded in 1992 (VFC Doc# 22815195, pg 11). Per the 2017 inspection, the inspector noted that two of the regulated tanks at the facility are used for emergency generator fuel storage. A violation letter was sent 11/15/21 and then site has not returned to compliance. In response to the records request dated 3/6/24, Kristin Sparks noted that they are making efforts to rectify and resolve the outstanding violations and that the 1K DSL and 10K REG tanks are planning on removing the two tanks in 2025. At this time, the 10K REG tank is completely empty and the 1K DSL tank is pending treatment prior to transferring to the Grant County Highway Department.

#### CM Notes:

- The 1K DSL tank is pending treatment prior to transferring to the Grant County Highway Department. They will be conducting monthly UST release detection for the 1K up until the fuel is removed.

## **Inspector Notes:**

- Operator C certificates were obtained on site.
- The photos in the compliance packet show the first two tanks are for generators
- The last tank is the 10K that is not in use. The tank meets temporary closure requirements as it was locked and has no fuel or liquids.

The following are AREAS OF CONCERN found during the inspection that will need to be addressed by the owner and/or operator:

1. A small amount of fluids/debris was found in the sump compartments and should be monitored and cleaned out when needed.
