Around 3:20PM there was an Emergency Alert for the 75 gallons of diesel spilled at the address of 7024 CR 311, Sellersburg, IN 47172. When I arrived at the scene the fire department and Gavin Hebner from Environmental Management Reponse were there cleaning up the wreck. No spillage had gone into the water drains or into any soils. Fire had used oil booms to stop the spreading before it got into any drains. When I spoke to the firefighters and Gavin, they had informed me that the individual transporting the drum of diesel for personal use in his personal vehicle. That same man had left the scene after it had happened, and nobody from fire got his name. It was cleaned up by the towing company and by the fire department. The towing company is Extreme Emergency Lighting owned by Lindsey and Todd Hooker, phone number 8122463030. The one that hauled everything away was Paul Lenmenkuler. Photos are attached.
