Comments: Carrie with INDOT TMC reports a 30 gallon hydraulic spill On SR 3. SRP is Dave Cornell. OSC Called SRP snd was told the city was bring sand out and a broom to clean it up. OSC asked for the city contact and SRP did not know the name or number. OSC attempted to find a number for the street dept but TXs was disconnected or unanswered. OSC called EMA and asked for a contact but the TX went to a voicemail. OSC finally contacted city to be told they had no contact from anyone on this spill. OSC call INDOT regional office and was told they had not been contacted. EMA called sheriffs dept and was given a TX for dispatch. OSC called dispatch and was put in touch with Officer Woods who is on site. He states the spill area is the size of a football field in length. OSC Contacted INDOT and they will contact HEPACO. SRP called and asked about an ETA OSC put him in touch with INDOT TMC.
