On July 1, 2024, Solid Waste Compliance Inspector Chad Pittman, a representative of the Indiana Department of Environmental Management, Office of Land Quality, conducted a routine compliance inspection of G. Estes & G. Estes Inc, d/b/a G.D. Estes & Co septage land application site located at 7911 Everman Road, Nabb, Indiana 47147 on Clark County property parcel 10-12-02-800-023.000-034.

G. Estes & G. Estes d/b/a G.D. Estes & Co. Septage Management Permit Number 126 is valid through August 1, 2026.

The previous septage land application inspection for G. Estes & G. Estes Inc, d/b/a G.D. Estes & Co. was conducted on August 10, 2023.

This inspection was conducted pursuant to IC 13-14-2-2. For your information, and in accordance with IC 13-14-5, a summary of the inspection is provided below.

The inspector met on-site with the business owner, Mr. Grafton Dale Estes, Jr. at 7911 Everman Road, Nabb, Indiana 47147 at 9:30 AM on July 1, 2024.

A visual inspection was performed on the permitted fifteen (15) acre parcel used for domestic septage land application (Site ID: 126-01 / 15 Acres / Township: 02N / Range: 09E / Section: 28).

All required markers are in place, and visible. No trespassing indicators, including purple paint, were present on the property as required. Setback rules are being followed.

At conclusion of the septage land application site inspection, it was determined the G. Estes & G. Estes Inc, d/b/a G.D. Estes & Co. septage land application site is in compliance with 327 IAC 7.1, IC 13-18-12, and the facility's septage management permit 126.
