Dear Mr. Mills:

On May 5, 2020, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM), Office of Air Quality (OAQ), received a request for an extension of compliance testing from SRT Investments LLC, dba SRT Aluminum (SRT) located at 50 Dimension Ave. in Wabash, Indiana. The compliance testing for Dioxins/Furans is required to be conducted by dates between May 19, 2020 and June 1, 2020 for Electric Induction Furnaces EF-1, EF-2, and EF-3 and for Reverberatory Furnaces RMF-1 and RMF-2 pursuant to Permit F169-42067-00066 Condition E.1.3.

According to SRT, the compliance testing cannot be conducted by the designated deadline due to a slowdown in available recycled aluminum charge and available workers in the midst of the current COVID-19 pandemic.

At this time, IDEM cannot approve your request to extend the permitted compliance testing deadline. Testing after the date specified in the permit constitutes a violation. However, if compliance testing is adequately performed in or before November 1, 2020, no enforcement action will be taken for failing to test before the original deadline stated in your permit.
