On June 26, 2024 you submitted an email requesting a 30-day extension for hazardous waste that will exceed the 90 days allowed for large quantity generators. The waste in question consists of forty-five (45) 55-gallon containers of investigative derived waste (F002), soil associated with an environmental investigation. The accumulation start date for the waste is March 29, 2024. The reason for the extension request is due to your disposal contractor is waiting for landfill approval.

Pursuant to 40 CFR 262.17(b) as referenced by 329 IAC 3.1, an extension is granted for this waste due to your extenuating circumstances. Be advised that no further extensions can be granted under Indiana Rules. If you are unable to ship your waste off-site before this 30-day extension expires, you should consider self-disclosing that you have exceeded the allowed time limit for a large quantity generator.
