

This site is a regulated UST site, so I believe Sherry Jordan will want you to submit info directly to her. IDEM Nawal Hopkin's has a 3-7-2024 comment in the ULCERS Database regarding the site, so is cc'd here.

Steve Lindway (INDoT) reported the following info that I entered into Tempo # 112149 (draft attached)- Steve Lindway (INDoT) notified IDEM that four (4) 7,900 gallon capacity UST's had been removed within an INDoT easement where INDoT is installing a new stormsewer system. He indicated E& B is the general contractor, which subcontracted 3\_D Company to remove the UST's. Mr. Lindway reported strong gasoline odor was encountered when the UST's were removed and the contractor air monitoring readings were between 10 to 30. He did not know what units of measurement, but OSC Smith assumes (and hopes) it is VOC ppm, veres % LEL. Smith aksed Mr. Lindway to ask the contractor what the units were. He indicated a frac tank is on-site and will be used to contain any liquids and that Patriot Engineering had been sub-contracted by 3-D Company and had pulled soil samples before the UST's had been removed. He indicated 3-D Company removed the UST's which contained flowable fill (sand) and that they put the impacted dirt and fill back into the excavation and powerwashed and crushed the UST's which were transported to a metal recycler.

Below is the screen shot from ULCERS database showing the UST's at the site- showing three (3) 7,900 gallon UST's, instead of four (4) Steve reported? I suspect you (INDoT) will find the two (2) 550 gallon tanks before they are finished?
