Dear Mr. Glover,

Regarding the notice received May 20, 2024. I want to make you aware of our corrective actions to comply with the permit. The Zinc overage is related to filter press issue. The filter cloth was not changed to the scheduled time due to a delay in the delivery from supplier. Stock level was low due to the low frequency of replacement of this filter. To prevent a recurrence of replacement part shortage, we increased our min stock level to 2 (attached screen shot below). We have not had a repeat of Zinc overage since June 2022.

Regarding the oil and grease quantities, the North oil and grease separator has been on a 6-month cleaning as of Dec 15, 2021 as evidenced in the enclosed 2<sup>nd</sup> screen shot of our FIIX system. The overages in December 2023 and March 2024 were isolated incidents due to hydraulic leaks in our paint processing equipment that went unnoticed and into the paint waste stream. We improved our maintenance program to check for such leaks on weekly basis.

I trust this documentation will satisfy the request for a response and provide evidence of compliance with the permit. If you have any questions or concerns, please let me know.
