Notice is hereby given that the Board of Trustees of the Town of New Providence, Clark County, Indiana, (commonly referred to as the Town of Borden) and the County Councils of the Counties of Clark, Floyd, Washington and Harrison, State of Indiana, pursuant to IC 1971, 19-3-1.1 have filed a petition with the Stream Pollution Control Board of the State of Indiana asking for the establishment of a regional water district to be known as the BORDEN-TRICOUNTY REGIONAL WATER DISTRICT.

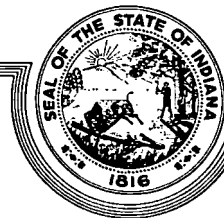
Said district, as proposed, will include contiguous parts of Clark, Floyd and Washington Counties, together with a strip of Harrison County lying on the county line road, encompassing substantially the area presently served by the municipal water utility of the Town of New Providence and the Tri-County Water Corporation.

Notice is further given that a public hearing will be held to consider said petition on Thursday, January 29, 1976, at 10:00 a.m., EST, at the Town Hall, Town of New Providence, Indiana.

Copies of said petition, which contain the exact location of the proposed water district, as well as other details of the proposal, are on file with the Indiana Stream Pollution Control Board, 1330 West Michigan Street, Indianapolis, Indiana, 46206.

Those who have yet to complete their appearance slips and desire to be heard should hand the slips to me and I will include them with the official record of this proceeding.

Oral statements will be heard, but written statements may be handed to the hearing officer at this hearing or mailed to the Office of the Hearing Commissioner, Indiana State Board of Health Building, Room A-412, 1330 West Michigan Street, Indianapolis, Indiana, 46206, within ten days after this hearing is adjourned. Comments will be considered by the Board before final approval of this Petition.
