Dear Ms. Warren:

On May 1, 2024, we received the *First Quarter 2024 Groundwater Monitoring Report* (Report) from you on behalf of the facility. The first quarter groundwater monitoring event took place between March 12-19, 2024. The following comments are the result of our review.

Both reports generally comply with the groundwater monitoring requirements of the following documents:

- Agreed Order Compliance Plan dated May 1, 2018 (VFC # 82536501).
- Proposed Site Closure Implementation Plan dated July 18, 2018 (VFC # 82582356).
- Approval of Closure/Post-Closure Plan dated October 17, 2019 (VFC # 82851197).
- Revised Statistical Evaluation Plan dated December 21, 2021 (VFC # 83256950)

Table 2 of the Report shows site-specific groundwater protection standard (GWPS) exceedances occurred for dissolved and total boron in groundwater monitoring wells MW-15D and MW-16D. The exceedances recur from previous events.

In addition to the GWPS, the facility compares dissolved boron concentrations against the alternate water supply limit (AWSL) of 2.0 mg/L to better characterize potential impacts to the residential water wells supplying neighboring homes. Per the Report, the facility bases the AWSL on the United States Environmental Protection

Agency's maximum permissible level of copper and lead to be stricter than the US EPA dissolved boron GWPS of 4 parts per million. Downgradient groundwater monitoring wells MW-13I, MW-14D, MW-15I, MW-15D, and MW-16D exhibited dissolved boron results above the AWSL.

The Report repeats the interpretation from previous reports that GWPS exceedances of boron in MW-16D are the "result of plume migration due to its location near the Consolidated Ash Management Area and the nearby extraction well EW-1 and EW-2R." We currently agree with this interpretation.

The Report shows past facility operations are still affecting the local unconsolidated geologic materials aquifer. However, the facility has documented groundwater quality improvements after initiating corrective actions with the groundwater extraction system. Therefore, the facility needs to continue operating the extraction system and monitoring groundwater quality following requirements specified in the aforementioned documents within this letter.
