Background Information:

The Emerson Avenue Landfill opened as a burn dump in 1958. The landfill stopped taking waste on October 1, 1978, under SPC-18. The landfill consists of approximately 31 acres across two different parcels of land. The northern property, Parcel #: 49-10-21-122-014.002-102, is owned by the City of Beech Grove. The southern property, Parcel # 49-10-21-122-005.000-101, is owned by Moorehouse Body Shop, Inc.

Comments:

On May 29, 2024, IDEM staff, Molly Hobbs (Solid Waste Compliance) and Kim Vedder (Geology), conducted a compliance assistance inspection of the Emerson Avenue Landfill. Mr. Criag Wiley, Mr. Robert Rund, Mr. Phil Gurganus, Mr. Brad Meriwether, and Mayor James Coffman were all present during the walkthrough to represent the City of Beech Grove. Mr. Donnie Moorehouse and Ms. Amy Moorehouse were present to represent Moorehouse Body Shop, Inc.

The inspection began at the access road with an opening conference with all parties involved. After discussing the nature of the inspection, the walkthrough of the site began.

City of Beech Grove Property

The inspection walkthrough began by walking to the northernmost corner of the landfill where a large erosion gully was observed during previous inspections. IDEM staff observed exposed waste on the access road to Lick Creek (*see attached photo log – photos 1-3*). A large erosion gully, approximately 5-feet deep was observed on the east side of the access road (*see attached map – leachate seep 1*). At the time of the inspection, IDEM staff observed leachate and exposed waste in the gully, along with the presence of landfill gas odor (*see attached photo log – photos 4-9*). IDEM staff followed the flow of water through the gully and into Lick Creek where more exposed waste was observed (*see attached photo log – photos 10 & 11*). IDEM staff informed Mayor Coffman that waste migrating off site should be addressed immediately and that violations may occur if the issue is not corrected.

The inspection walkthrough continued west along the creek bank. IDEM staff observed water ponding on the landfill along the bank. IDEM staff observed many leachate seeps along the creek bank while walking to the western access road to the creek (*see attached photo log – photos 12-25 and attached map – leachate seep 2-4*).

IDEM staff walked back up the northwest access road to the creek to continue the inspection of the landfill cap. IDEM staff observed a wooden structure on the landfill cap near the northern corner of the cap (*see attached photo log – photo 26*). IDEM staff advised Mr. Coffman that the structure needs to be removed from the landfill cap and disposed of properly.

IDEM staff then viewed the grassed waterway with riprap dams, added to slow the movement of surface water drainage on the landfill cap (*see attached photo log – photo 27*). At the time of the inspection, there was water collecting within the grassed waterway (*see attached photo log – photo 28*). Ponded water on the landfill creates opportunity for surface water to infiltrate the landfill cap and increases the likelihood of leachate. IDEM staff recommends correcting the ponded water area and adjacent riprap dam to allow water flow through the rip-rap dam and promote positive drainage off the cap. Repairs may require regrading and/or reconstruction of the riprap dam.

IDEM staff then viewed the outlet of the grassed waterway on the northeast waste boundary line. At the time of the inspection, IDEM staff observed a large gully with leachate and exposed waste (*see attached photo log – photos 29-37 and attached map – leachate seep 5*).

The walkthrough continued southeast along the waste boundary line. IDEM staff observed more exposed waste and leachate along the southeast waste boundary (*see attached photo log – photos 38-44 and attached map – leachate seep 6*). At this point, IDEM staff crossed the property boundary line into the parcel owned by Moorehouse Body Shop, Inc.

Moorehouse Body Shop, Inc. Property

The walkthrough of the Moorehouse Body Shop, Inc. property began at the northeast waste boundary line. IDEM staff observed a grassed path cleared of vegetation along the property boundary. Along the path, IDEM staff noted areas with ponded water (*see attached photo log – photo 45*). IDEM staff recommends regrading areas of ponded water to promote positive drainage off the landfill cap. At the time of the inspection, IDEM staff observed a leachate seep along the access path on the Moorehouse Property (*see attached photo log – photo 46 and attached map – leachate seep 7*).

IDEM staff then viewed the area that Mr. Moorhouse stated trespassers often enter the property at on the northeast corner of the property. At the time of the inspection, IDEM staff observed ponded water and vehicle ruts from off road vehicles (*see attached photo log – photo 47*).

The inspection walkthrough concluded back at the main access road with a closing conference between all parties. IDEM staff left the property at approximately 3:00 PM.

Recommendations:

- Remove wooden structure off the landfill cap and properly dispose of it.
- Repair the grassed waterway to promote positive drainage off the landfill cap.
- Regrade the cleared access path to promote positive drainage and prevent ponding of water.
- Submit a plan to IDEM’s Antique Landfill Coordinator that describes how the leachate seeps will be repaired.
- Continue to work with IDEM’s Antique Landfill Coordinator until completion of the project.

Confidential Information

A check in the “does” box is not a written claim for confidential treatment of information acquired during this inspection.

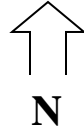

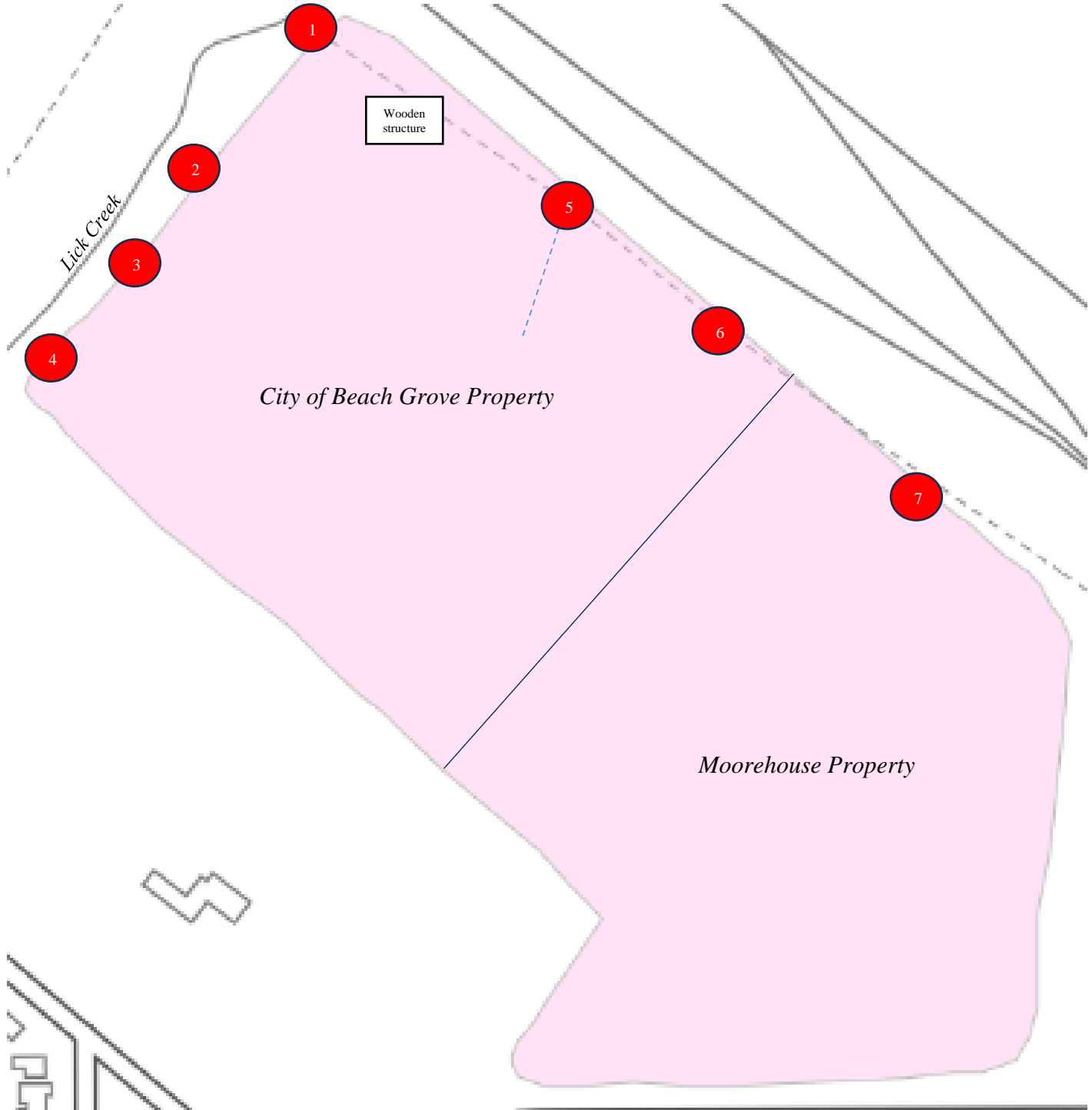
