Ponds in the Lake Forest subdivision were checked with no evidence of pond applications. OSC determined that discoloration was originating from the W. OSC determined that 10 ponds in the Brookside subdivision had been treated with Aquashade on 6/28/24. Rain event pushed material from the ponds into Kirkendall Creek. OSC notified the City of Westfield MS4. OSC also made contact with ASAP Aquatics who performed the application.</p>
