To Whom It May Concern:

In accordance with Condition C.16 of our Part 70 Operating Permit referenced above, this letter describes our actions in response to the stack test results for Stack AF-6 (meal grinding) for testing performed April 18 & 19, 2024.

The results of the April 2024 test included filterable and condensable particulate. The combined results for Run 1 were below the applicable permit limits, while the combined results for Runs 2 and 3 were above. For all three runs, the filterable results were relatively low and consistent (between 0.21 and 0.3 lbs./hr.), while the higher condensable results for Runs 2 and 3 contributed to the exceedance of the combined limit for those runs and the overall average.

Although the filterable particulate results therefore did not indicate concerns, in an abundance of caution, we performed an inspection of the bags and a dye test shortly after receiving the results. As expected, no significant filter bag performance issues were identified.

Historically, condensable emissions results for this process have been consistent with the results of Run 1, which were well below the permitted emission limit. Although we have not identified a specific cause for the higher condensable emission results in Runs 2 & 3, we note that the extraction process had not been running smoothly the week of the test. Indeed, the test was originally planned to begin on April 16, but was delayed by two days until steady operation could be achieved for the duration of the runs. Therefore, it is possible that the April 2024 test results did not represent normal operation of the plant and that some temporary factor led to the condensable results for Runs 2 & 3.

We currently plan a re-test on or about July 9 to confirm compliance with the permit limitations and have submitted a protocol notice to IDEM for that purpose.
