The purpose of this inspection was for a routine CFO and exit inspection.				
Mr. Wendel wishes to exit the CFO program due to no longer meeting the definition of a confined feeding operation for				

Mr. Wendel wishes to exit the CFO program due to no longer meeting the definition of a confined feeding operation for swine.

Mr. Wendel understands by exiting the CFO program that in the future, if he decides to increase the number of animals to 300 cattle, 600 swine or sheep, or 30,000 fowl, that he must first obtain a new approval.

The current permit for this facility has an effective date of 4/26/2021 and an expiration date of 4/26/2026. The renewal submission due date is 3/27/2026.

Mr. Scott Kreuzman provided a signed copy of Mr. Wendel's Request to Exit the CFO Program form (please see the attached copy CFO Exit Form).

The current permit allows for 1,950 grow-to-finish hogs, 40 farrowing sows with litters, 650 nursery pigs and 238 gestating sows. Per Mr. Wendel, this facility has been completely depopulated as of the fall of 2023.

I inquired about the future intended use of the CFO facility. Mr. Wendel indicated that he will continue to raise a few fattening hogs and will not raise more than 599 hogs at any point in the future.

All Operating Record Requirements were reviewed and were up to date including the Emergency Spill Plan, Storm Water Management and Self Inspections, and Land Application Records. There were no operating record violations.

The most recent manure analysis was completed on 11/6/2023 and is valid for one (1) year.

The most recent soil analysis was completed for various fields the spring of 2022 and they are valid for four (4) years.

The manure from the former hog confinement facility has been pumped out of the barns, and properly land applied by Mr. Steve Wendel in April 2024 (please see the attached photographs of the inside of the barns – the pits although shallow, did not photograph as it is dark inside of the barns).

A visual inspection of the barns was completed. There is adequate vegetative groundcover and gravel surrounding the barns. No storm water issues were noted.

Mr. Steve Wendel has a valid fertilizer applicator's license with the OISC.

Mortalities had previously been rendered. No issues were noted with the mortality compost area.

A copy of this inspection report will be forwarded to the IDEM CFO Permit Section for their review.

Description of Violations and Further Actions

The findings noted in this report do not include a compliance evaluation for the submittal of required construction notifications, construction affidavits, facility change notifications, as-built plans, waste storage structure closures, and special compliance monitoring reports or data.




