First the crew used a 3000 gal vac truck to vac up approx. 150 gals of liquid in the road. After that the crew spread Oil Dry to absorb the liquid in on the concrete and asphalt. The next day the crew came back and swept up all the Oil Dry. We spread more Oil Dry in the areas that needed more. The crew used brooms to scrub in the Oil Dry. Than swept up. The crew used a Hydro Vac to vac out the drywells using soapy water to clean them. Once the asphalt, conree, and drywells were cleaned up, the crew used the Hyro Vac to excavte all contaminated soil.
