**Description of area:** The burn unit is owned by Blue Heron Ministries. The area is mostly level to slightly rolling. There is a pine plantation in the southwest corner which consists of mixed White Pine, Red Pine, and Scotch Pine. Along the southern half and eastern boundary that isn't part of the pine plantation is an oak woodland that is in the process of thinning out undesirable trees to become more open. In the center of the unit there is an open prairie that mostly contains weedy grasses and forbs but does have some native vegetation. To the north of the open area is a maple wet woods.
