Inspection Narrative
<p>An inspection was conducted at Dayton Freight Lines located at 100 Novae Parkway in Markle, Indiana. Mr. Joe Brown, Terminal Manager, and Sheila Brockhaus, Customer Service Specialist, represented the facility during the inspection. This Dayton Freight facility typically operates from Monday at 7:00 a.m. to Saturday at noon. Approximately 110 people are employed there, including drivers. There are ~5 people working at the facility on a regular basis. The facility has notified as a small quantity generator of hazardous waste.</p> <p>Dayton Freight is a regional transporter of various products including various hazardous materials. Product deliveries are received during third shift and are offloaded at the docks. Products are then loaded onto trucks for deliveries during the day. Hazardous wastes are generated from products that are damaged during shipping activities, including loading and unloading products. When products are damaged, an incident report, or "alert", is generated and the shipper is notified. If the shipper cannot use the material it is determined to be waste and managed accordingly. Maintenance on vehicles, etc. is conducted by a third party. There were no used oil or other used vehicle fluids onsite at the time of the inspection.</p> <p>A tour of the facility was conducted including the docks, non-hazardous dumpster storage and the <180-day storage area. At the time of the inspection, 1 overpack drum containing a damaged 55-gallon drum of paint (D001), dated 6/12/24, was stored in the <180-day area. A copy of the alert/incident report is attached. No violations were noted.</p>

The facility representatives, Sheila Brockhaus and Lindsey Fennelly, conduct weekly inspections of the <180-day storage area, and the logs are maintained onsite. Employee responsible for the management of hazardous waste, including signing manifests, labeling, conducting inspection, etc., are trained and receive annual refreshers.

No violations were noted during the inspection.
