Dear Ms. Garling:

By this letter, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) notifies you that the above referenced Administrative Order (AO) has been terminated.

In the AO, issued on September 15, 2005, the U.S. EPA found that Lake Cicott Campground had violated the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), 42 United States Code § 300f through 300j-26 (1996), and Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 141. The U.S. EPA ordered Lake Cicott Campground to achieve compliance according to the specified schedule.

Our records show that your water system has met the requirements of the Administrative Order by collecting total coliform bacteria and nitrate samples during September, 2005 before you closed for the season, and in May, 2006, within 9 days after re-opening in the Spring. The results were satisfactory. Lake Cicott Campground also provided public notice for the total coliform bacteria and nitrate monitoring violations cited in the AO, and is now in compliance.


Termination of this Administrative Order does not relieve Lake Cicott Campground of its obligation to comply with the SDWA and its implementing regulations.
