INTRODUCTION

The Indiana Department of Environmental Management's (IDEM's) Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) requires a Community Relations Plan (CRP) to be submitted as part of the site's Work Plan (in accordance with the non-rule policy document WASTE-0049-NPD). Geocel Corporation has been very proactive in regards to informing the community and potentially affected parties about the site. Many of these activities occurred as soon as contamination was discovered in the residential area located south of County Road 106 and include:

- Informing residents of the potential for contamination via door-to-door canvassing of the neighborhoods during sampling activities;
- 2) Making telephone calls to residents informing them of their residential water well sampling results;
- 3) Creating an informational website (<u>www.meadowfarmsupdate.com</u>) that potentially affected parties can access to obtain a substantial amount of information regarding the site and submit e-mail questions;
- 4) Creating a telephone hotline that potentially affected parties can use to ask questions or be provided with information;
- 5) Delivering flyers to residents within the neighborhood informing them of the creation of the website, telephone hotline, and the public information forum;
- 6) Holding an open public information forum that included poster presentations and informal question and answer sessions;
- 7) Releasing multiple press releases to local news outlets (newspapers, radio stations, and television stations).

The above activities, along with the basic components of IDEM's CRP described in this plan, create an effective Community Relations Plan for the Geocel site (VRP #6070601).

1.0 POTENTIALLY AFFECTED PROPERTY OWNERS/OCUPANTS

The following table includes properties that had their private water wells sampled, properties where monitoring wells have been installed on their property, and properties adjacent to the Geocel facility. A total of 50 out of the 115 residential properties did not have any detections of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) in their wells during two (2) separate sampling events conducted in 2007.



8.0 SIGNAGE

The Geocel Corporation site is clearly identifiable at 2504 Marina Drive with commercial signage (see picture below).



Additionally, the potentially affected parties near the site have already been notified of potential contamination issues through door-to-door canvassing during sampling activities, flyers delivered to their homes, and/or via the public meeting that was held on August 7, 2007 (as described in Section 9.0). The total impacted area covers numerous individual properties over an approximately 24.6-acre area. As such, no additional signage is warranted.

9.0 ADDITIONAL COMMUNITY RELATIONS ACTIVITIES

In addition to the basic components of the CRP described in previous sections, Geocel Corporation has performed several other activities relating to informing nearby potentially affected parties.

- Initial Private Water Well Sampling RES and Elkhart County Health Department (ECHD) personnel sampled 115 residential wells in June/July 2007. As part of these sampling activities, each resident was provided a letter from the ECHD informing them of the potential for contamination. Ninety (90) homes were also re-sampled in August 2007 in order to confirm their initial results. Each resident was informed of the resampling event via a door-knob flyer that was left at their home. During each sampling event, residents were notified of their results via a telephone call and/or by supplying the resident with their actual laboratory sampling results. A letter from the ECHD also accompanied the lab results. A copy of the ECHD letters, door-knob flyer, and a map showing the homes that were sampled are provided in Appendix A. Additionally, the private wells associated with the industrial properties located north of County Road 106 were also sampled in 2007. These included: two (2) private water wells at the Keyline Sales property; a private water well at the Marine Fasteners property; an irrigation well at the Hadley property (former Dygert Seating); and an irrigation well at the ACT property.
- Informational Website A website was created in June 2007 to help inform the public about the Geocel VRP site, www.meadowfarmsupdate.com. The website includes general geologic information, contaminant information, history, maps, events, a "what's new" section, a question/answer section, and a contacts page. Potentially affected parties can also e-mail questions or concerns regarding the site. A toll-free telephone hotline, (800) 699-1493, was also initially established in lieu of those portions of the public who do not have readily available internet access. The toll-free hotline was recently discontinued.
- Delivery of Flyers Informational flyers were delivered to residents in the area on three
 (3) separate occasions in June, July, and August 2007. Copies of the flyers are provided in Appendix B.
- Public Information Forum A public information forum was held on August 7, 2007, in order to inform potentially affected parties about the Geocel VRP site. Two (2) sessions were held at the Matterhorn Conference Center located on Cassopolis Street in Elkhart from 2pm to 4pm and 6pm to 8pm. The forum included several poster presentations showing site conditions and potential remedial activities. Experts were also available to answer questions from the public, including: a toxicologist, a hydrogeologist, and county/state regulatory agency personnel. Another public information forum was held on April 21, 2008, (6pm at the Hillcrest United Methodist Church) in order to inform residents about upcoming municipal water installations. Engineers were present at this meeting to answer technical questions from the residents regarding the installation of municipal water.

Dear Resident:

The Elkhart County Health Department's, Environmental Health Services Division is conducting residential water well sampling and testing in your neighborhood. Currently there is no evidence that any residential wells are contaminated. This testing is being conducted due to your homes proximity to an industrial park that has been in existence for many years. The potential exists that such industrial parks may have had unknown historical releases, which could impact neighboring residential areas. This sampling and testing event will help us determine if any such spills or releases may have impacted residential wells.

There is no cost to the occupants or homeowner for this testing event.

A representative of the Elkhart County Health Department will be present with proper credentials during all sampling events.





It is our goal to keep the MeadowFarmsUpdate.com Web site as up to date as possible; we will continue to issue new information as soon as it is available. Please send us an e-mail if you would like to be notified when new information is posted.

For the 13 homes that were found to have contaminants above the Environmental Protection Agency's recommended maximum levels, we have retained a toxicologist to help answer questions. Please call our hotline or send us an e-mail and we will see that your questions are appropriately answered. You may also contact the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry Region 5 Environmental Hotline at (800) 621-8431, ext. 36086. For all other homes that were tested, there were either no contaminants detected, or they were within levels allowed under the EPA's Safe Drinking Water Act.

We recognize that some of you may prefer one-on-one contact to discuss these issues. With that in mind, we are planning to hold a public information forum on August 7. There will be two sessions: 2 p.m - 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. - 8 p.m. The location of this meeting is to be determined. In the meantime, please continue to visit our Web site, call or e-mail us to get answers to your questions.

What are we doing now?

We have just been notified by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) that our Voluntary Remediation Application has been approved and we have been assigned a project manager. Next we will be working on the Remediation Work Plan and will be working with IDEM to gain approval for specific tasks so we may begin remediation prior to approval of the official work plan.

Our actions have not stalled during this planning process; our environmental consultant is currently installing monitoring wells, which will be used throughout the remediation process to monitor groundwater chemistry and groundwater fluctuations.

We want to reassure you that we are deeply committed to resolving the issues that result from this contamination, and we continue to work on an aggressive timeline to address the issue.

We have planned two public information sessions to answer questions surrounding the recently discovered contamination that traveled underground from the Geocel site into the nearby Meadow Farms neighborhood.
