Dear Mr. Giles,

This letter is to inform Indiana Department of Environmental Management of the results of our well survey for residents immediately west of Harman-Motive property. This area includes all residents within the area of concern and a line of houses along Ohio Street immediately adjacent to this area. (See attached map)

A total of six wells were found in the survey. Three wells are inside the area of concern. Of these wells, two were abandoned years ago and are no longer usable. One well is being used by the resident, who indicated its purpose is watering the lawn/garden and washing cars. He indicated the well has never been used for drinking water. All three owners of these wells are connected to the Martinsville city water supply.

The three wells in the area immediately west of the area of concern are all being used by the residents. One of the wells is used by the resident for watering a garden, washing cars, etc. Both of the other two wells are located on the same property. One well is located in the garage and is used for outside activities. However, the other well is used by the resident as a drinking water source. Even though this well is outside the area of concern, we recommended that the resident hook up to city water. The resident agreed and this should be completed this month.
