A representative of the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM), Office of Air Quality, has reviewed your Annual Compliance Certification (ACC) for the year 2015 submitted by Hoosier Energy REC, Merom Generating Station, located at 5500 West Old State Highway 54, Sullivan, Indiana. As a result of information obtained during that review, IDEM has identified that the deviations reported are violations of permit numbers T153-34565-00005 (1/1/15 - 6/14/15) and T153-35203-00005 (6/15/15 - 12/31/15).

Our records indicate that no prior Violation Letter was issued regarding the following deviations reported in your ACC:

- 1) C.2 - Opacity
- 2) D.1.5 – NSPS Opacity

It is your responsibility to ensure that these violations are corrected immediately and do not re-occur.

The Office of Air Quality will not take legal action at this time for these violations. However failure to comply with provisions of this Violation Letter or repeated violations in the future may result in legal action and assessment of civil penalties pursuant to IC 13-30-4-1.

The Compliance Data Section (CDS) of the Office of Air Quality will be evaluating any violations related to monitored excess emissions or continuous monitoring upset conditions and may take additional action related to those as merited.
