Re: Monitoring Requirements for  
Transient Public Water Systems  
New Point of Entry (POE) - 02 (West)  
PWSID #2290027

The Indiana Department of Environmental Management's Drinking Water Branch (DWB) has been notified that your public water system has a new POE. For clarification purposes, this new POE will be referred to as POE 02 (West). **Please make sure the correct POE and PWSID number are included on all correspondence and report forms submitted to the DWB.** It has been determined that you operate a ground water system serving a transient population of twenty-five (25) and a nontransient population of one (1) for a total population of twenty-six (26). There are several drinking water contaminants that you are required to monitor for at this new entry point. All samples must be analyzed by a certified laboratory and must be submitted to the DWB within ten (10) days of the end of each monitoring period. A list of certified laboratories has been included for your use.

**Total Coliform:** You are required to continue to sample quarterly for Total Coliform. We require that you collect two (2) samples each quarter, representing each well. **Your next samples are due in the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter (October 1 – December 31) of 2016.** If you have any questions concerning your bacteriological monitoring requirements, please contact Mr. Willi de la Rosa at (317) 234-7445.

Please submit a revised site sampling plan. Contact Ms. Carrie Lowe at (317) 234-7426 for questions on the plan.

**Nitrate:** You are required to monitor for Nitrate annually at your new POE (02 – West). This sample must be collected at the entry point to your distribution system after all treatment, and must represent all source water serving that entry point. **You are to begin sampling for Nitrate in 2016.** If you have any questions concerning monitoring requirements for nitrate, please contact Mr. David Forsee at (317) 234-7442.

**Nitrite:** You are required to monitor for Nitrite once during 2016 at your new entry point (02 – West). This sample must be collected at each entry point to your distribution system after all treatment, and must represent all source water serving that entry point. If you have any questions concerning monitoring requirements for nitrite, please contact Mr. David Forsee at (317) 234-7442.

*Please note: Separate and distinct test kits are required in order to monitor for each contaminant. Analysis shall only be conducted by laboratories that have been certified by EPA or the commissioner.*


