The Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) has reviewed your two Self-Disclosure and Environmental Audit application forms of December 19, 2016, concerning Material Handling Exchange, for the facility located at 1001 Hurricane Street, Franklin, Indiana, under IDEM's Self Disclosure and Environmental Audit Policy. By letter of December 22, 2016, IDEM informed you that the submittals were administratively complete.

In your first application, you reported to IDEM that Material Handling Exchange had not been routinely collecting pH samples on a daily basis as required by its IWP permit and also, through a sample conducted by a contract consultant, recorded a pH result of 10.1, which exceeds the effluent limitation for pH as contained in its IWP permit.

In your second application, you reported that the contract consultant, while auditing procedures, disclosed that although the IWP permit had been modified effective October 5, 2015, to recognize batch discharges of treated wastewater, the company had continued to discharge continuously.

IDEM has concluded that neither of these reported violations qualifies for protection under IDEM's Self Disclosure and Environmental Audit policy. However, because the pH sample result showing a violation of the permit limitations was analyzed outside the allowable holding time the results are not valid and are unenforceable. The failure to sample pH at the required frequency also violates the permit requirements, but since this oversight was immediately corrected, no IDEM enforcement action is anticipated. Further, since Material Handling Exchange promptly requested a permit modification to go back to continuous discharge, and such permit modification was



granted by the permit revocation/reissuance of February 28, 2017, and effective March 1, 2017, no IDEM enforcement action concerning this issue is anticipated.
