I am submitting this letter in response to a letter you sent on April 27, 2017 regarding the desire to accept waste at the Tanner's Creek Type 1 Landfill from an offsite source. You listed 11 issues that need to be addressed as part of a minor modification request, our response to those 11 issues is below and attached you will find the required forms and supplementary documents.

1. Good character disclosure statements for Tanners Creek Development, LLC and its responsible parties. Forms for submitting the good character information are enclosed.

c. A description of the process(es) generating each waste stream.

The gypsum waste is byproduct of flu gas desulfurization, where a lime slurry is sprayed into the exhaust of a coal fired power plant to chemically react with the SO_x and NO_x to remove it from the exhausted gases. The byproduct is calcium sulfite, which is then further oxidized to produce gypsum.

4. Whether or not the offsite waste is recently generated or excavated from waste stored for an extended period of time, particularly waste placed in a surface impoundment or lagoon. Please include clarification whether or not any stored waste was mixed with other waste that is not coal combustion fly ash, bottom ash, or flue gas desulfurization byproducts. If the waste contains materials that are not coal combustion fly ash, bottom ash, or flue gas desulfurization byproducts, you will need to conduct waste classification testing as outlined at 329 IAC 10-9-4. Waste will come from both recently generated sources and temporary stock piles at the specified sties. The waste material will be exclusively coal combustion byproduct, and will not contain any other wastes.
5. Description of the procedures you will use for waste acceptance and screening (329 IAC 10-9-4(a)).
Waste will only be brought into the site from the listed power plants on barges, the gypsum waste will be the only waste loaded into the barges and will be screened prior to loading. The specific and exclusive nature of the sources and transportation remove opportunity for an unapproved waste being accepted. There will be no public access or acceptance of public waste.
6. Discussion on how waste will be offloaded from the barges and then moved to the landfill. Include how you will manage the waste to prevent its loss into the area between the barge and the landfill.
Waste will be offloaded and transported to the active face of the landfill using enclosed conveyors. Once it is conveyed to the active face it will be moved and graded with dozers.
7. The tipping fees you will charge to accept the waste.
The fee will be \$10/ton.
8. Description of how you will determine the tonnage of waste received in order to calculate the landfills annual operating fees(IC 13-20-21-4) and solid waste management fees (IC 13-20-22).
Tonnage will be measured when loading the barges.
9. Discussion on how long and how much total waste/materials will be accepted for disposal at this landfill, and estimated schedule for closure of the landfill at the plant.
We estimate accepting 725,000 tons of material over the course of 18 months. Material will be brought in on barges. The landfill is projected to be closed by 2021.

10. Description of access control, particularly how you will comply with 329 IAC 10-28-1(b).
Site will have access controlled by a gate, which will be locked when personnel are not on duty.

Memorandum to Address 329 IAC 10-11-7
Demonstration and Determination of Need

This memorandum is being written as a means to address the requirements expressed in 329 IAC 10-11-7, "Demonstration and Determination of Need Requirement" as it relates to the requested minor modification to the Tanners Creek Type I Landfill Permit. This facility is seeking a permit modification to accept gypsum, a coal combustion residual, from two separate Dayton Power and Energy facilities. The request is being made to take waste exclusive to this waste type, and these specific power production facilities. Further, it will be demonstrated that the Tanners Creek Type I Landfill, and the Dayton Power and Energy power plants will both benefit from this exchange and no other entities will be negatively impacted.

- I. Description of the anticipated area that would be served by the facility as indicated by the following:
 - a. Solid waste management districts or portions of districts
The waste is coming from outside Indiana, both facilities are located in Ohio, and as such neither are located in a solid waste management district. The Tanners Creek Type I Landfill is located in the Dearborn County waste management district, however it has never accepted waste from the public nor does it intend to, as such this district will also remain unimpacted. The already approved construction plans for the Tanners Creek facility will not be not be altered, capacity will not increase, the allowed waste type will not change, the only change that is being requested is the waste generator. Because the Tanners Creek Power Plant has been shut down and is being demolished, it will no longer be generating waste for disposal in this landfill.
 - b. County, multiple counties or portions thereof.
Tanners Creek Landfill has not nor will it accept waste from the public, nor will any waste be generated from power production at the now closed Tanners Creek Power Plant and diverted from the Tanners Creek Type I Landfill to be disposed of at other facilities, as such no counties will be impacted.
 - c. County, multiple counties and a state (if area includes portions outside of Indiana).
The locations the waste is generated at are listed below, they are sites in Ohio.

- i. Dayton Power & Light Company - J.M. Stuart Station

II. Description of the existing solid waste management facilities that serve the same described area
These power plants are both being served by a privately owned on site disposal facility, however this facility is near capacity and will not be able to serve the future needs of these power plants.

III. Description of the need that would be fulfilled by constructing the proposed facility, as follows:

- a. For Facilities proposed in areas with approved district solid waste management plans, a description of the need identified in the district solid waste management plan required by IC 13-21-5.

Construction of the Tanners Creek Landfill has already been approved, there is approximately 1,000,000 cubic yards of air space left in the facility as already permitted. This is a request for a minor modification to use offsite waste from two specific power producing facilities in place of the waste that was forecasted to be generated by the Tanners Creek Power Plant prior to the plant closing. The two facilities that would be exclusively served by this arrangement are both located in Ohio and outside of the Indiana solid waste management districts.

- b. For facilities proposed in areas without approved district solid waste management plans, a description of the need for the proposed area to be served.

The Tanners Creek Type I Landfill will serve two Dayton Power and Energy power plants, located in Ohio. These plants have used nearly all of their available waste disposal volume and need to send the gypsum waste offsite.

IV. Description of the recycling, composting, or other activities which the facility would operate within the proposed area of service.

The facility would continue to operate as a Type I landfill, disposing of coal combustion byproducts from power generation facilities.

V. Description of the additional disposal capacity which the facility, if permitted, would provide for the proposed area of service.

The facility is already permitted to take an approximately 1,000,000 more cubic yards of coal combustion byproducts under the existing permit. The facility is not seeking an expansion.
