Dear Mr. Centeno:

On June 11, 2020, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM), Office of Air Quality (OAQ), received a request for an extension of compliance testing from Superior Aluminum Alloys, L.L.C. located at 14214 Edgerton Road in New Haven, Indiana. The compliance testing is required to be conducted by June 17, 2020 for Reverberatory Furnace #5 pursuant to T003-40531-00286, Condition D.1.5 Testing Requirements, and 40 CFR 63, Subpart RRR.

According to Superior Aluminum Alloys, L.L.C., the compliance testing cannot be conducted by the designated deadline due to the decrease in demand for aluminum as a result of COVID 19.

At this time, IDEM cannot approve your request to extend the permitted compliance testing deadline. Testing after the date specified in the permit constitutes a violation. However, if compliance testing is adequately performed by August 31, 2020, no enforcement action will be taken for failing to test before the original deadline stated in your permit.
