INSPECTION OBSERVATIONS AND COMMENTS
<p>On December 22, 2020, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM), Office of Air Quality (OAQ), received a complaint regarding open burning taking place at property owned by Mr. Fred Schrader. The complainant, Officer Joshua Schoon reported that he observed an incidence of open burning taking place on Fred Schrader's property. Officer Schoon's complaint states upon inspection of the contents of the fire, Officer Schoon indicated that he observed the following contents being burning: a tire, plastic water line, large wooden spools used to transport electrical wire. Officer Schoon also reported that he observed green flames in the fire, which he stated that Mr. Schrader indicated may be the result of electrical wire insulation contained within the fire. Upon speaking with Officer Schoon on December 31, 2020 regarding the open burning incident, I asked Officer Schoon if he believe the material being burned was generated as the result of any type business operations, and Officer Schoon stated that he was uncertain.</p> <p>On January 6, 2021, I conducted an inspection of the open burning incident. Upon arrival at the property, I was greeted by Mr. Fred Schrader, to who I described the purpose of my visit. I asked Mr. Schrader if his property is used for residential or commercial use. Mr. Schrader stated that he operates his business, CID Services Incorporated, from the property. I then asked Mr. Schrader if any of the materials Officer Schoon observed being burned on December 22, 2020, originated from the operations associated with CID Services Incorporated. Mr. Schrader then stated that the materials did not originate from CID Services Incorporated but were miscellaneous items he obtained over time for personal use. I then asked Mr. Schrader if he could accompany me to the area in which the open burned was conducted.</p> <p>Mr. Schrader then accompanied me to an area located on the southeast corner of the property, were he indicated the material was being burned. At the time of the inspection, no evidence of open burning was observed. The area in which Mr. Schrader indicated that the burning took place was covered by snow, and Mr. Schrader also indicated that he covered the area with soil as well. I then advised Mr. Schrader of the state's open burning rules, specifically against the prohibition regarding the open burning of trash.</p>
