## **INSPECTION OBSERVATIONS AND COMMENTS**

Upon arrival, I noted that the source is still under construction. At the time of the inspection, it was noted that the construction company was in process of erecting the buildings steel support beams. Upon discussions with Ms. Tena Hopkins regarding operations scheduled to take place once the source is complete, Ms. Hopkins indicated that the facility will be used to provide steam service to the Purdue University – Wade Utility Plant, which is located directly adjacent to the west. Ms. Hopkins also indicated that the facility is scheduled to begin commercial operation in the fall of 2021. Upon speaking with Mr. Andy Anderson regarding construction of the facility, Mr. Anderson indicated that no emission units have been installed as of the date of the inspection. Additionally, it should also be noted that an assessment was made during the permitting process to determine if the source should be considered the same source as the adjacent Purdue University – Wade Utility Plant. Based on the results of the evaluation, it was determined that the source would not be considered the same source as common control/ownership of the two entities does not exist.
