Re: Inspection Summary/ Enforcement Referral Coalmont Coalmont, Clay County

An inspection of the above-referenced facility or location was conducted by a representative of the Indiana Department of Environmental Management, Office of Water Quality, pursuant to IC 13-18-3-9. A summary of the inspection is provided below:

Date(s) of Inspection:	May 12, 2022
Type of Inspection:	Reconnaissance Inspection
Inspection Results:	Violations were observed and will be referred to the Enforcement Section.

The following concerns were noted:

A complaint, that was originally submitted to EPA on November 9, 2020, was forwarded to the IDEM inspector on March 25, 2021. The complaint states that complainant lives in a community (Coalmont) that has no sewage system. Water from sinks and washers run into ditches, along with possibly sewage. The complainant is concerned about public health issues related to septic wastewater in roadside and back yard ditches. This was originally inspected on April 1, 2021 by IDEM staff with a subsequent visit on May 12, 2022. Conditions noted in the April 1, 2021 inspection are still present.

410 Indiana Administrative Code 6-8.3-52 states that: No person shall throw, run, drain, seep, or otherwise dispose into any of the surface waters or ground waters of this state, or cause, permit, or suffer to be thrown, run, drained, allowed to seep, or otherwise disposed into such waters, any organic or inorganic matter from a dwelling or residential on-site sewage system that would cause or contribute to a health hazard or water pollution.
(b) The: (1) design; (2) construction; (3) installation; (4) location; (5) maintenance; and (6) operation; of residential on-site sewage systems shall

comply with the provisions of this rule.

Pursuant to Indiana Code (IC) 13-30-2-1(1), a person may not discharge, emit, cause, allow or threaten to discharge, emit, cause, or allow any contaminant or waste, including any noxious odor, either alone or in combination with contaminants from other sources, into the environment.

Pursuant to IC 13-18-4-5, it is unlawful for any person to throw, run, drain or otherwise dispose into any of the streams or waters of Indiana; or cause, permit, or suffer to be thrown, run, drained, allowed to seep, or otherwise disposed into any waters; any organic or inorganic matter that contributes to a polluted condition of any waters, as determined by a rule of the board adopted under sections 1 and 3 of this chapter.

Based on the inspector's observations, many septic systems in the community may not be compliant with the aforementioned Indiana State Department of Health rule and also appear to be discharging directly to waters of the State. This is a violation of the above referenced regulations and the County must address this public health and water quality issue.

Within 10 days of receipt of this letter, a written detailed response documenting correction of the concerns listed above and/or a plan for assuring future compliance must be submitted to this office. Please direct your response to this letter to our letterhead address or via email to OWQenforcement@idem.IN.gov. Additionally, this matter is being referred to the OWQ Enforcement Section for appropriate action. If formal action is initiated, you will be issued a Notice of Violation informing you of how to proceed in resolving this matter.
